

Nameplate necklace- DIY the fancy name jewelry

This nameplate necklace tutorial is to demonstrate you a quick and easy way to make out cool-looking name jewelry merely with shrink plastic.

For that silver/gold name jewelry, you have to take care from time to time, owing to their easy-to-tarnish property. But this nameplate necklace will never have that problem, because the name pendant made up of painted shrink plastic can keep burnished all the time along.

Materials and tools:

- Printable plastic
- Ink-jet Printer
- Nail polish
- Nail file
- [Iron chain](#)
- Jump rings
- Acrylic sealant
- [Clasp](#)
- Puncher
- Scissors



Instructions:

Step 1: print name pattern

- 1st, type your name and print it out on prepared plastic;
- 2nd, cut out the excess blank part and get the name pattern;
- 3rd, file the sharp edges of name pattern.



Step 2: polish name pattern

- 1st, sent it to oven and heat it up;
- 2nd, flatten it and punch two holes at both ends;
- 3rd, paint a layer of nail polish to strengthen the color and then another layer of sealant.



Step 3: finish off nameplate necklace

After it dries, attach jump ring and chains with a clasp installed on.
