

DIY tutorial-how to make a hemp bracelet with beads in several minutes

This is an easy and creative bracelet making tutorial. By learning this, you will figure out another extremely speed way about how to make a hemp bracelet with beads in a few minutes.

To make a simple bracelet to trade with friends or stack on your own wrist, the hemp may be one of most ideal supplies. Much like twine, hemp can be shaped and designed into various patterns due to its stiff nature. As to this how to make a hemp bracelet with beads project, thread your selected tube beads onto the hemp strips and you will make your unparallelled hemp bracelet.



Things you'll need for your hemp bracelet:

- [Hemp](#)
- Cord ends
- Lobster Claw Clasp
- [Jumpring](#)
- Glue
- Scissors

How to make a hemp bracelet with beads?

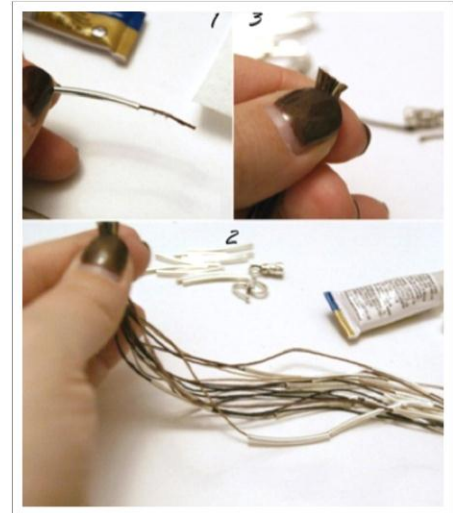
Step1: prepare hemp strands

1. Figure out how many strands of hemp will fill in the cord end aptly;
2. In my hemp bracelet, I need 14. Align the ends of all hemp and insert them into one cord end together. Secure with drops of glue. Let it dry aside.



Step2: string on the selected beads

1. Thread two or three selected tube beads onto each strap randomly. Act the same process for all hemp strands;
2. Gather together all tail ends. Measure the length of hemp bracelet and cut off excess portions neatly;
3. Attach on another cord end and secure with glue in same way.



Step3: assemble on clasps

Add on clasp on either end of your bracelet by one Jumpring.



Voila, you have your new bracelet ornaments now! How long did it exactly take, 5 or 6 minutes? You can even add more layers by adopting a larger size cord end. Or on contrary, in case of you'd like to reduce the number of hemp strands, try tying an overhand knot at beginning and ending before insert the strands into the cord end.
