

The easiest method on how to make macrame bracelets adjustable

It's another bracelet making tutorial, at meanwhile, I'll emphasize the subject about how to make macrame bracelets adjustable in simple way again. Especially for those who learn to knot for just several days, I recommend this!

In general, macrame is a type of craft that make use of hemp, yarn or many other string materials, and plus a series of intricate or easy knot tying techniques to create specific patterns. Styles of the items may vary from fashion to vintage due to the supplies and techniques adopted. This project is all about how to make macrame bracelets and additionally how to make macrame bracelets adjustable.



Supplies needed:



- Dark-Red [Nylon Thread](#)
- Rhinestone [Brass Chains](#)
- Lighter
- Scissors

How to make macrame bracelets adjustable?

Step1: prepare the string strands

1. Measure the cord around your wrist, twice the circumstance and that's the needed length. Cut 4 of these;
2. Align both 4 stripes and then tie an overhand knot at 5cm from the beginnings;
3. Regard the central two strands as main holding ends and then start with one Square Knot;
4. Before the next process, insert your Rhinestone brass chain. Anchor it by one same Square knot;
5. Continue with tying square knot between each two Rhinestone beads on the chain until you reach the end of chain.



Step2: how to make macrame bracelets adjustable

1. Again, work 3 or more square knots at the end by 4 string strips;
2. Reserve the holding ends on both tips, trim off extra threads and melt the endings with lighter;
3. Create an adjustable closure. Cross the four remaining ends, take an extra short thread to tie several above square knots (normally I will work 2 or 3 of these);
4. Remove excess string of newly added working ends, then seal in same way with lighter;
5. Tie one overhand knot on both sides.

Done! Try on it around your wrist and that's truly wonderful for stacking. I hope you have practiced this simple tutorial and enjoy the tips on how to make macrame bracelets adjustable. Have a nice weekend!
