

Creative friendship bracelet pattern-how to make a wavy friendship bracelet

With some strands of string, you can work actually creative friendship bracelet pattern along with the way you knotting. It is an essentially easy-to-follow project for a wavy friendship bracelet from string.

For a friend, one piece of friendship bracelet is the most personal testaments you can promise to other. Celebrate your friendship while working out this truly creative friendship bracelet pattern as the symbols of love and care between you girls. There, in this project, you will learn a stunning wavy friendship bracelet from string. Here we go!



Materials needed for wavy friendship bracelet:



- 1mm [Nylon thread](#)
- 6mm Abacus [Glass Bead](#)
- Scissors
- Lighter

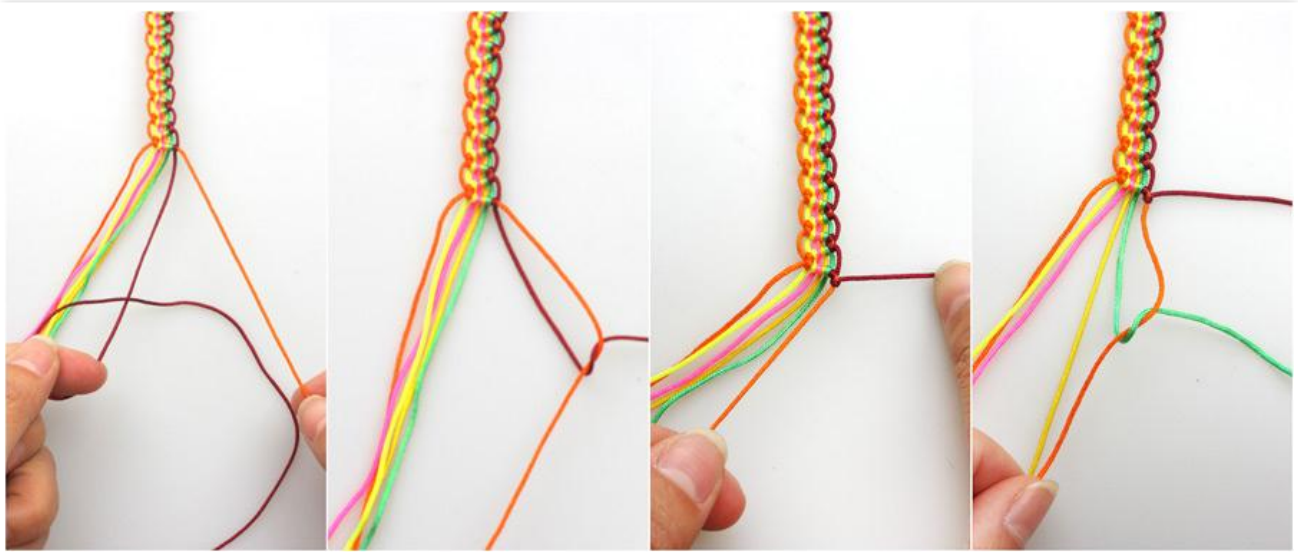
How to work the wavy friendship bracelet?

Step1: string preparation

Decide the number of string you want to give your bracelet. In my project, I used 6 longer working ends and 1 shorter holding end;

Step2: work the knots

1. Bundle up seven string strands at 7cm long from beginning ends with an overhand knot;
2. Pick out your holding end (Orange in my project), and spread rest 6 working ends on flat;
3. Nip working end in your right hand. Take the first working end, next loop it around your index finger in clockwise;
4. Pass the working end through the loop;
5. Tighten the loop;
6. Do same processes for the rest 5 working ends in orders;
7. Turn the direction from right to left and keep working same processes.



Step3: conclude the wavy friendship bracelet

In the end, make one extra loop with each working ends to make the knots stay in place.

Step4: design a closure

1. Cut off the excess holding string at both ends and fusion with lighter;
2. Reserve 7cm long tails for each ends, and then cross with the leftover parts. Take another string strip and work several Square knots as closure;
3. Adorn one 6mm Abacus Glass Bead on each end tail.



Voila, this is your wavy friendship bracelet! This creative friendship bracelet pattern may be recommended among both novice and veteran. Hope that you have enjoyed it!
