Easy jewelry crafts for kids-diy button rings in 3 steps

When you assemble buttons with versatile wires you get these cool diy button rings. And thanks to the accessibility of supplies and processes, I also recommend it one of easy jewelry crafts for kids.

How to turn the scrap buttons lying around into fashion accessory to coordinate with an outfit or just for fun? Since there are a variety of ways to make diy button rings, I suggest this one out of one button and a few centimeters of wires. What's more, even the tyro can handle it easily, I'd like to show it here as one of the easy jewelry crafts for kids so that they may get a new opportunity to practice.



Supplies needed for diy button rings:

- Thin Soft Wire
- <u>Button</u> (shank button or one with two holes)
- Tape measure (optional)
- Wire-cutter Plier

Instructions on the diy button rings:

Step1: cut a strand of prepared wire, about 50cm, or less of it for small hands.

Step2: nip one end of the wire and thread it through the two holes on button. Then keep wrapping around the finger directly or use an assistive tape measure.

Step3: when there leave only 10cm long wire, wrap the excess tail around the coils.

Step4: flatten and tuck the sharp end in. there is one sample of diy button rings.



Except the diy button rings, we may also combine it with blank clip for an amusing hair ornament or with strip of cord for a wonderful bracelet up and down on your wrist. Whatever, in my opinion, buttons are just beautiful and versatile stuffs. Collecting them in a bottle and inspire more easy jewelry crafts for kids to make with.
