

Primary bracelet project-make a hemp bracelet patterns with beads

Here, in this bracelet project, you may get your first chance to practice the skills. Hope you may love these hemp bracelet patterns with beads.



Supplies needed in the bracelet project:



- Colored hemp twine
- Eyepin
- [Glass pearl bead](#)
- Wire-cutter Plier
- Round Nose Plier

Guides:

Step1: preparation

1. Put the 2 pearl beads onto eyepin and loop the end with Round Nose Plier;
2. Grab the hemp twine and snip two strips twice the length of your wrist circumference.



Step2: set out to do the bracelet project

1. Pass the two strands of through two loops beside the beads respectively;



2. Knot at the location on hemp strings that make the bracelet fits snugly around your wrist;



3. Cross stack the excess tails, work with another strand of hemp twine for a natural closure consist of square knots.



The result is this, easy and smart! Probably this bracelet project is a little inferior to most hemp bracelet patterns with beads, but whatever, it is just one for trios. Come up with more inspires and try stacking together, maybe it will result in a magic thing. Nice days!
