

List of Supplies Needed for Not Granny's Quilt

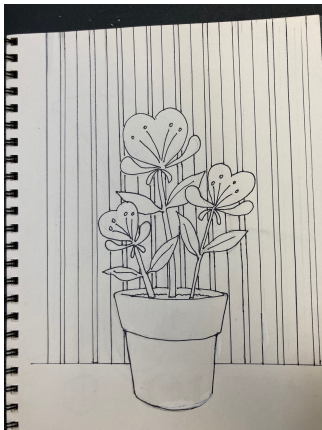
- White cotton fabric - about 9" x 12" or slightly larger. This can be a tone-on-tone fabric. That means a white fabric with a design printed in white. This printing will resist the colors of paint.



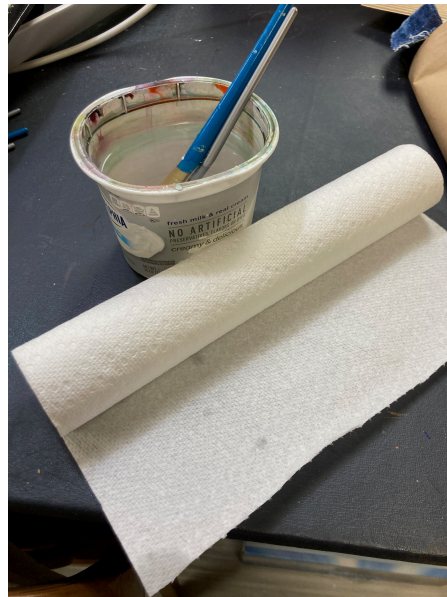
- Black Fabric pen - Micron in various sizes or Pentel Gel Roller for Fabric
- Various Brushes - short, synthetic bristles in sizes 1/2 inch flat, 1/4 inch flat, #8 round, #2 round. They need to have short stiff bristles.



- Fabric Paint and/or markers - Use Derwent Inktense Pencils and Blocks as well as Fabiano Fabric Markers. I have also recently acquired a set of Fabric markers from American Art Supply. They have a fine point and a chisel point and my set is 24 markers.
- An Image to use for subject. This can be a tracing from a photograph, a drawing you do, a page from a coloring book or something downloaded from Dover Clip Art.



- Paper towels to use under you work to keep bleeding to a minimum.
- A water container.



- A light box (Optional) or you can use a window for tracing you image onto the fabric.
- A smile and a can-do attitude.
