

Diy earring holder-a framed lace pattern project

Get some many earrings that you don't know what to do with? Today, I will show you a diy earring holder tutorial. By practicing this and you'll have all your earrings well-organized and ready to use.

I like earrings, and I buy them as well as diy and wear them. However, the trouble of misplacing the mate of each pair had nagged me so many times and I am sure some of you get into the same trouble with me. Hence, I'm so proud to state that I have explored my way-a framed lace diy earring holder.



Things you'll need in diy earring holder:

- Photo frame
- Lace
- Staple gun
- Scissors

Details of the diy earring holder:

Step1: Separate the frame out. You'll need to remove the glass, backing and the back. If your frame is actually stubbornly affixed one side, use the razor blade to cut it.

Step2: Cut a piece of lace, overlap the inner frame by about 2cm.



Step3: Find the groove where the glass hangs out. Hold your lace tautly and staple down.



When full attached, hang on your favorite earrings.



Lace allows you to hook all types of dangling earrings in place and the frame can be displayed vertically or horizontally to accomplish completely harmony of your room. All in all, it is not only a diy earring holder, but also a fabulous home décor. The vintage photo frame and lace are all the stuffs that can be bought easily in stores. Enjoy yourself though!
