

## DIY projects- wrap bracelets with names

Our DIY projects aim to provide you fresh and steam lined approaches to creative braided bracelets with names. And what we present now is a simple one.

There are many DIY projects regards how to make friendship bracelets with names. However most of them, even in distinctively colorful pattern, are done in double hitches way, that is, the patterns are created by forward and backward knots. This one is different, as it involves a new way called wrapping method.



### Materials and tools:



- Plastic bangle
- Yellow [nylon threads](#)
- Purple nylon threads
- [Scissors](#)
- Glue
- Lighter

### Instructions:

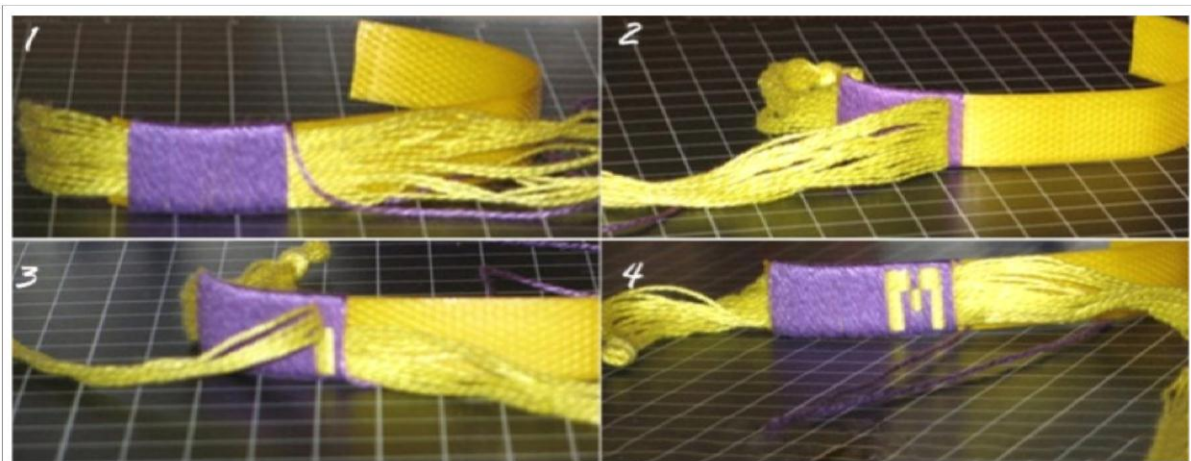
#### Step 1: wrap up letter M

1<sup>st</sup>, cover yellow threads over plastic bangle, making them the letter color;

2<sup>nd</sup>, wrap purple thread around yellow one and bangle, making them the background color;

3<sup>rd</sup>, pull back yellow threads, wrap it over purple threads, and again wrap purple over yellow;

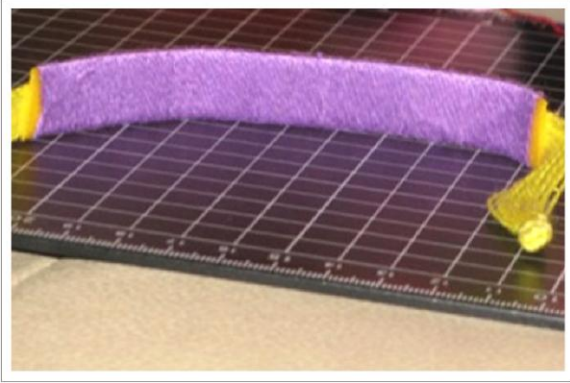
4<sup>th</sup>, finish off the first letter M.



### Step 2: wrap up the rest letters

1<sup>st</sup> the same way to make out the rest of letters, and make ending knots with purple threads at both ends;

2<sup>nd</sup>, trim off the excess threads.



### Step 3: finish the bracelet with name

Singe the ends of plastic bangle and knot yellow threads at both ends.
